1 S.A. Resolution #39 2 Establishing an Ad-Hoc Committee for Investigating Course Absence Policy Reform 3 4 ABSTRACT: This resolution establishes an ad-hoc committee with the goal of investigating 5 Cornell's Course Absence Policy. At the conclusion of their investigation, the committee will issue 6 recommendations to the Student Assembly and the Cornell Administration on actions which could 7 be taken to ameliorate and enforce Course Absence Policies at Cornell University. 8 9 Sponsored by: Varun Devatha '19, Julian Kroll '20 10 11 Whereas, there are very few institutional requirements put into place dictating how Course 12 Administrators must treat course absences, 13 14 Whereas, extensive anecdotal evidence suggests Course Administrators are often unwilling to 15 permit excused absences, even in clearly extenuating circumstances, 16 17 Whereas, Cornell undergraduates are known to struggle with undue levels of stress in relation to 18 academic matters and unduly restrictive absence policies clearly exacerbate this stress, 19 20 Be it therefore resolved, that the S.A. establish an ad-hoc committee titled "Cornell Student 21 Assembly Task Force on Course Absence Policy Reform' (hereafter CAP-TF) effective immediately, 22 23 Be it further resolved, that the CAP-TF will be tasked with investigating existing course absence 24 policies, drafting new course absence policies, and exploring systems by which these policies could 25 be effectively implemented. The findings of the committee shall culminate in a report delivered to 26 the Student Assembly and made available to the greater Cornell community, 27 28 Be it further resolved, that all current and future efforts of the S.A. to reform course absence 29 policies be settled exclusively through the CAP-TF, 30 31 Be it further resolved, that the CAP-TF will be composed of 4 members and 1 chair. The members 32 may be voting or ex-officio members of the Student Assembly or the Student Assembly Academic 33 Policy Committee. The chair must be a voting or ex-officio member of the Student Assembly. The 34 chair of the Academic Policy Committee and the Student Assembly Liaison to the Faculty Senate 35 Educational Policies Committee shall sit on CAP-TF as ex-officio members, 36 37 Be it further resolved, that the CAP-TF will convene at least once each month. An agenda and 38 relevant documents will be distributed to CAP-TF members at least 24 hours before the start of 39 each meeting, 40 41 Be it finally resolved, that the Student Assembly will appoint members to the CAP-TF during the 42 next executive session following the successful passage of this resolution. 43
